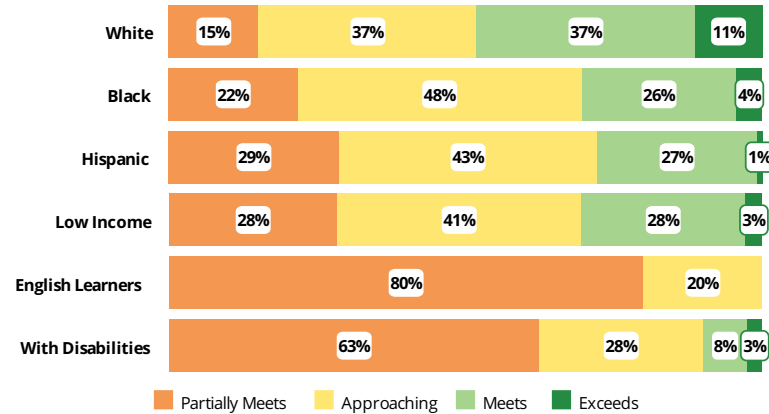
Academic Success

Success by Student Group

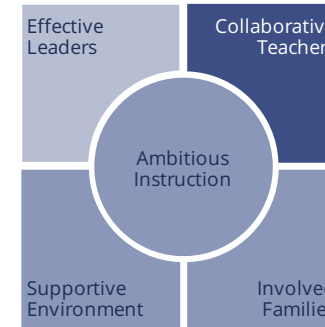

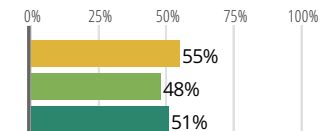

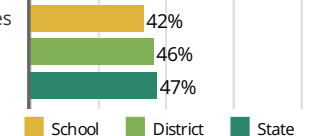
Ready for College Coursework

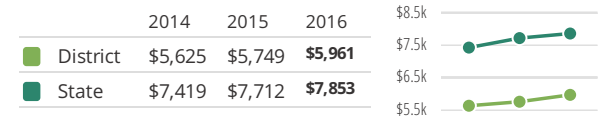

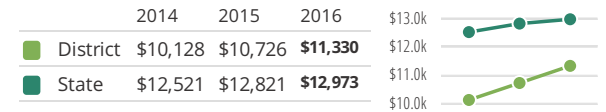

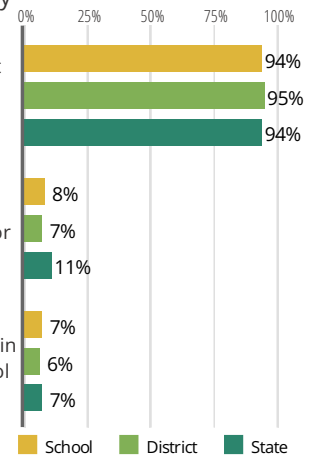
Educator Measures

Student Attendance and Mobility

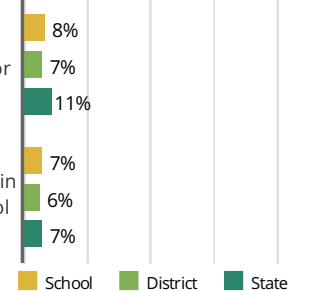
Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences



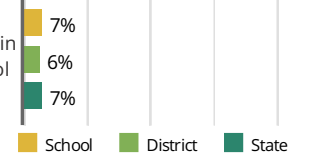
Chronic Truancy Rate
