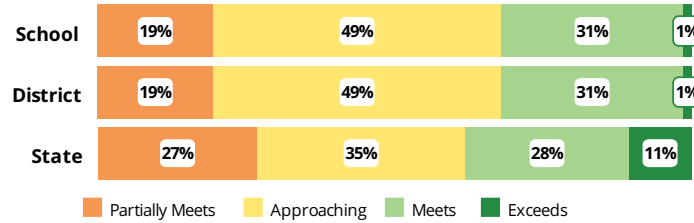

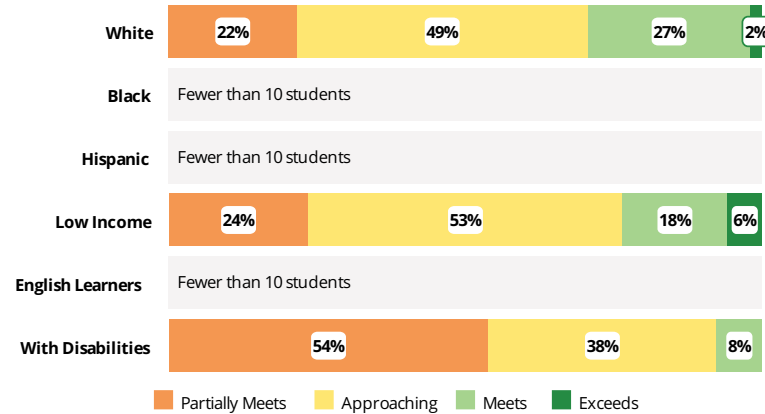
Academic Success

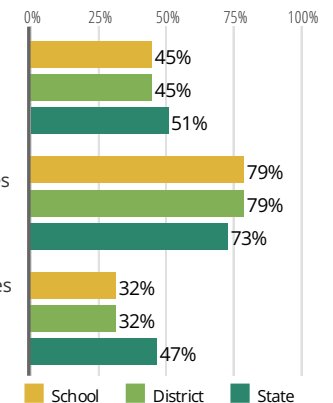

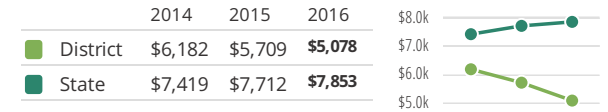

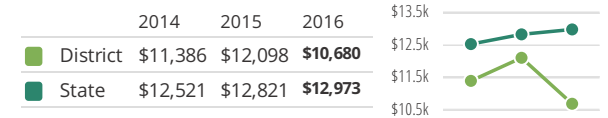
Calhoun High School houses the James A. Ringhausen Gymnasium. It was dedicated to the memory of James A. Ringhausen, an avid member of the school district and community.

Attendance Rate

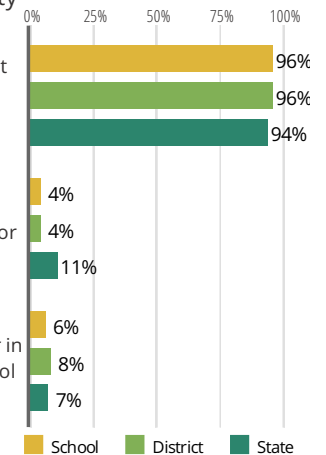
