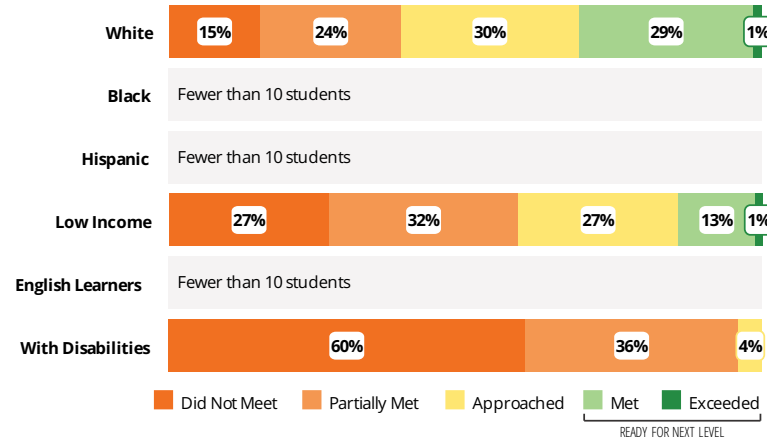
## Academic Success

This display shows PARCC performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.

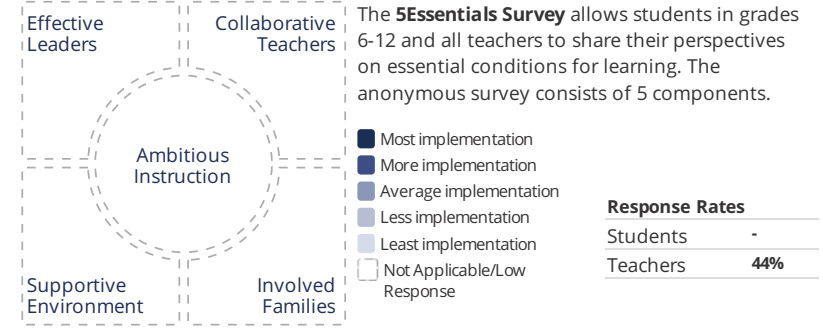

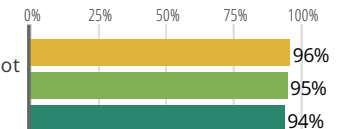

## Student Attendance and Mobility

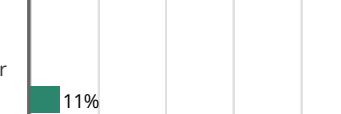
### Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences



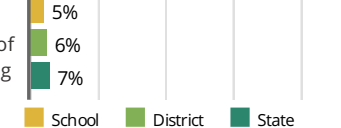
### Chronic Truancy Rate

## School Highlights

### Academic Courses

Crestwood School offers a well rounded quality education. Students are engaged in a challenging curriculum. Students participate in technology, art, current events, art history, military history, study skills, and character education. Eighth grade students are provided with a ThinkPad laptop of their own to use for the school year.

### Physical Education, Heath and Wellness

Students participate in health courses and pe daily. Our school wide wellness plan encourages activity breaks in the classroom. A nutritious breakfast and lunch menu is served daily. Nonfood rewards are encouraged. Crestwood School was named a Healthier US Schools Bronze Winner from the US Department of Agriculture.

### Other Programs and Activities

Students participate in the DARE program. Students mentor elementary students through our Mentoring Program. Students can participate in art club, drama/chorus, concert band/marching band/pep band, scholastic bowl, science club, student council, ecology team, geography bee, service club, spelling bee, bus patrol, FCA, and yearbook club.

### Career Development Courses and Programs

Students are exposed to many careers through a program called Career Cruising. Career Fairs are conducted at Crestwood. Local business men and women share their careers with students through mini seminars. Students also attend a Career Fair at Lakeland College. Careers are researched in our social studies, language arts, and technology courses.

### Athletics

Our students have the opportunity to participate in school teams for boys' baseball, boys' basketball, boys' track and field, girls' basketball, girls' softball, girls' track and field, cheerleading, girls' volleyball. Five IESA state trophies were added to our shelves during the 2015-16 school year. Two IESA state trophies were earned in 2016-17.

### School Personnel Resources

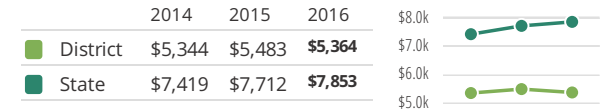
Crestwood school is fortunate to have caring and well-educated teachers who have obtained advanced degrees and even national board certification. The school has a variety of subject area specialists and support staff.

### Facilities

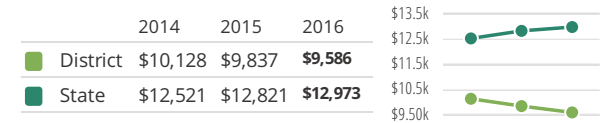
