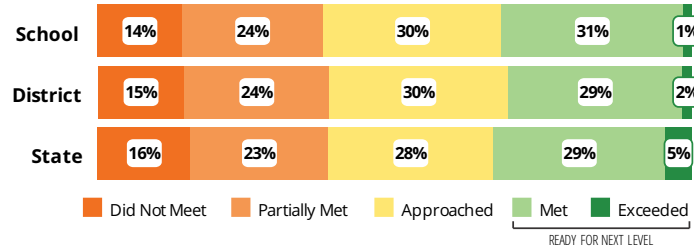

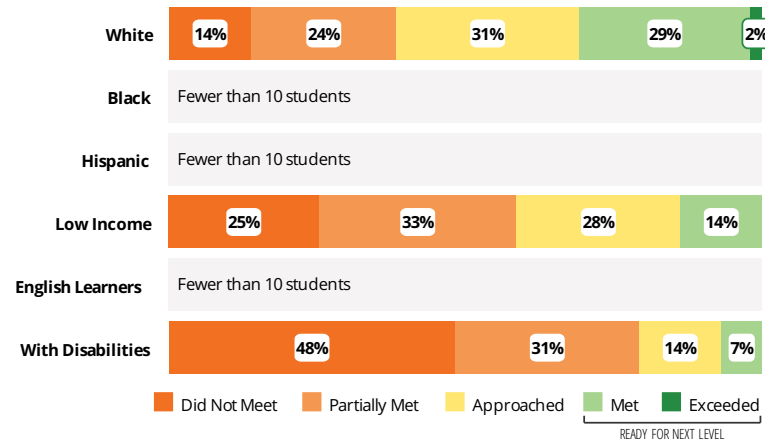
Academic Success

Success by Student Group

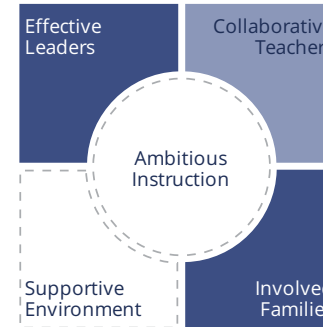
This display shows PARCC performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.

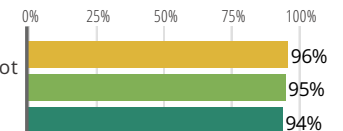

School Highlights

Academic Courses

Crestwood School offers a well-rounded quality education. All students participate in daily walk-to groups at their instructional level. All grade levels offer an engaging curriculum complimented by specialty areas of technology, art, character education, and music. Students have the opportunity to participate in band.

Physical Education, Heath and Wellness

All elementary students participate in daily physical education. Our School Wellness Plan encourages activity breaks in the classroom. Teachers encourage healthy snacks in the classroom. When indoor recess is necessary, students are involved in physical movement.

Other Programs and Activities

PTO sponsors family nights and school wide programs. Students serve as mentors. Our guidance department teaches Character Ed to all students. PBIS teaches and rewards positive behavior. Too Good for Drugs, DARE, & Ag in the Classroom are community-sponsored activities. We partner with the high school to offer a variety of enrichment activities.

School Awards

Crestwood Elementary School was recognized at the Platinum level by PBIS. 70% of our certified staff hold at least one master's degree.

Career Development Courses and Programs

Each month elementary classrooms have guest speakers, during character education, to talk with students about their careers and how they help others in the community. Students participate in field trips to further their knowledge of careers. Soft skills are taught throughout each grade level to develop students' organizational and social skills.

Athletics

Boys' and Girls' Basketball school teams are available for elementary students. These teams are coached by volunteers. Students are encouraged to participate in local leagues of softball, football, baseball, golf, soccer, basketball, dance, karate, and dodge ball. Flyers are sent home frequently from area businesses to encourage physical activity.

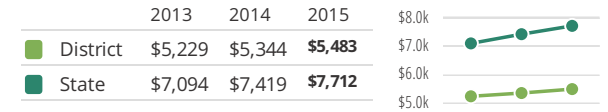
Crestwood school is fortunate to have caring and well-educated teachers who have obtained advanced degrees and even national board certification. The school has a variety of subject area specialists and support staff.

Facilities

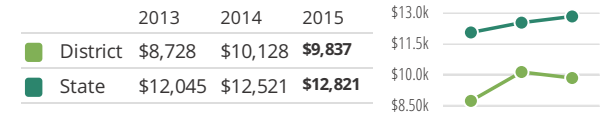
Built in 1955, Crestwood School has been well maintained and provides an excellent learning environment for students with gym space, a media center, computer labs, outdoor nature center, and spacious outside play area. A ten year survey of the facility was recently completed that will ensure the health and safety of students remains a top priority.

District Finance
