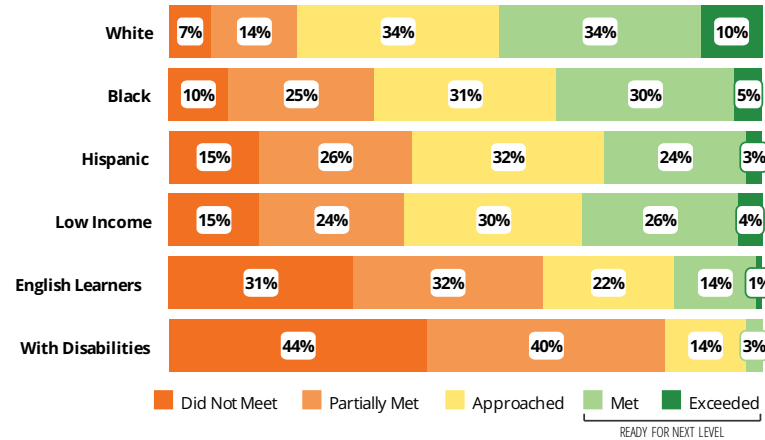
Academic Success

Success by Student Group

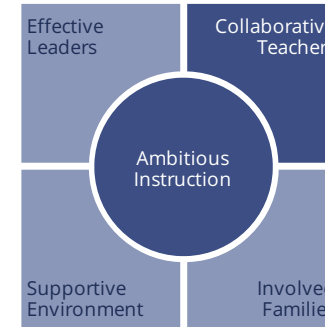
This display shows PARCC performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.

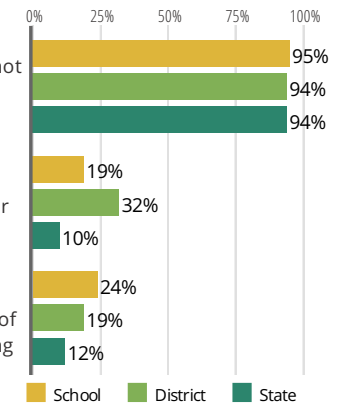

Hayt School has developed a three year physical education plan to increase the physical activity of all students, kindergarten through 8th grade. Hayt currently has two P.E. teachers on staff.

Hayt begins supervising students at 7:30 a.m. After school, Future World offers after school care until 5:30. Fees may apply. In addition to sports, Hayt does offer a variety of activities ranging from Roots and Shoots to Science Club to Robotics.

Hayt follows the CPS fall, winter and spring sport programs offering after school activities to students 5th though 8th grade. Sports include volleyball, basketball, & soccer.

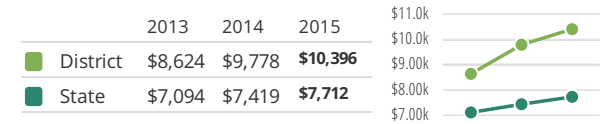

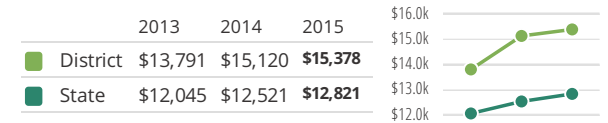
